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# Bible Verses for Daily Life Forgiveness

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. (Colossians 3:13)

#### **DISCONTENT**

What makes us so discontented with our condition is the absurd, exaggerated idea we have of the happiness of others.

The grass generally does look greener on the other side of the fence, doesn't it? Why should that be?

Insecurity can mean lack of self-knowledge. It has been said that if we were allowed to trade our troubles with someone else, chances are we would choose to keep our own. However, observing others' lives, we are often misled. The couple we envy because they are apparently so devoted to one another indeed may be. Then again, their personal relationship may be much more shallow and less satisfactory than ours. The person always talking about how devoted her children are to her may be devastatingly lovely and neglected. The rich and famous, who apparently have it all, may be lacking in some of the things that make our lives abundant.

The truth is we are made rich by what we give. And we all have the ability to give. There is no need to envy those whom we perceive to be full of truth, beauty, goodness, and love. These are gifts for the taking. Be observant. Be aware of the necessity to look beneath the surface.

Rather than discontent, let loving and accepting be our motivating force.
